An important component of the TIES IELTS Preparation course is the use of past IELTS papers in preparation for the examination. Therefore the course aims to help students excel in this particular type of testing with an emphasis on each Macro-Skill and techniques to achieve the best result possible.

As the IELTS test is a test of English language proficiency it is essential that each student's English level is appropriate for the course. Therefore, students must have an IELTS score of 5.0 or above, or be at an Upper-Intermediate English level to study IELTS Preparation at TIES. If a student does not meet those requirements, they will first need to successfully complete the TIES General English Intermediate course (subject to availability).
